	Feed back Loop Participants	Course Delivery type	Positives	negatives
Concept maps	Groups or individuals – to instructor instructors – back to group or individual individual before to individual after instruction!	Small lecture – active learning – possibly on-line	“snapshot” of understanding Builds over time Progress map for student reflection	Hard to grade Time consuming for instructor if a large class Must be taught Can be hard to construct

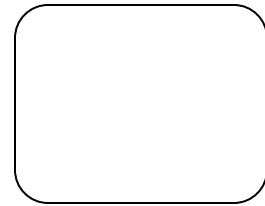
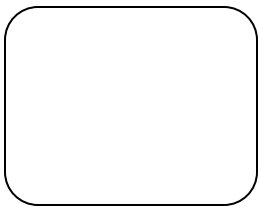
